YOUR ACTION REQUIRED! New Purdue Master Gardener Policy

By now you have all heard that there is a new Purdue Master Gardener Policy. We are in the process of getting all Hendricks County Master Gardeners integrated into the system. This means all Master Gardeners who wish to remain active must take action before September 1, 2015.

So, here is what you need to do to be integrated into the new policy:

Read the MG Program Policy Guide (MG-5-W). This can be downloaded for free from Purdue's Education Store at: https://mdc.itap.purdue.edu/item.asp?item_number=MG-5-W#.VWhyN2NgSVo

Return a completed and signed Purdue MG Volunteer Application and Agreement form to Angie Tilton. You can scan them and email them to tilton@purdue.edu or you can snail mail them to Purdue Extension- Hendricks County office at PO BOX 7, Danville IN 46122. You can access the form on the MG website or Purdue-Extension Hendricks County's website.

Provide evidence of government-issued photo ID- **this must be done in person**. Please do NOT mail a copy of your driver's license to the office. We must check all photo IDs in person. You can come to the Purdue Extension-Hendricks County office anytime Monday – Friday, 8 am – 4 pm to have your photo IDs verified in person. In addition, Angie and Chase will be at the July Picnic to check IDs and we will also check IDs at upcoming MG monthly meetings.

So, please remember to get those photo IDs checked in person and please submit your completed and signed Volunteer Application and Agreement forms asap.
